| | Mental health – to focus completing the crisis support project, and also carrying out the ward visits to St Andrews hospital. | |
| | 2. Hospital discharge - to explore replicating the discharge survey that HWN carried out and reported on in 2017. | |
| | 3. Primary care - the remit of a project is not yet determined. There is an interest in GP services and also in oral health/dentistry - one idea is to explore access to primary care for vulnerable groups. We heard that the University of Northampton is carrying out a research project on Patient Participation Groups (PPGs) which we will find out more about. | ВС |
